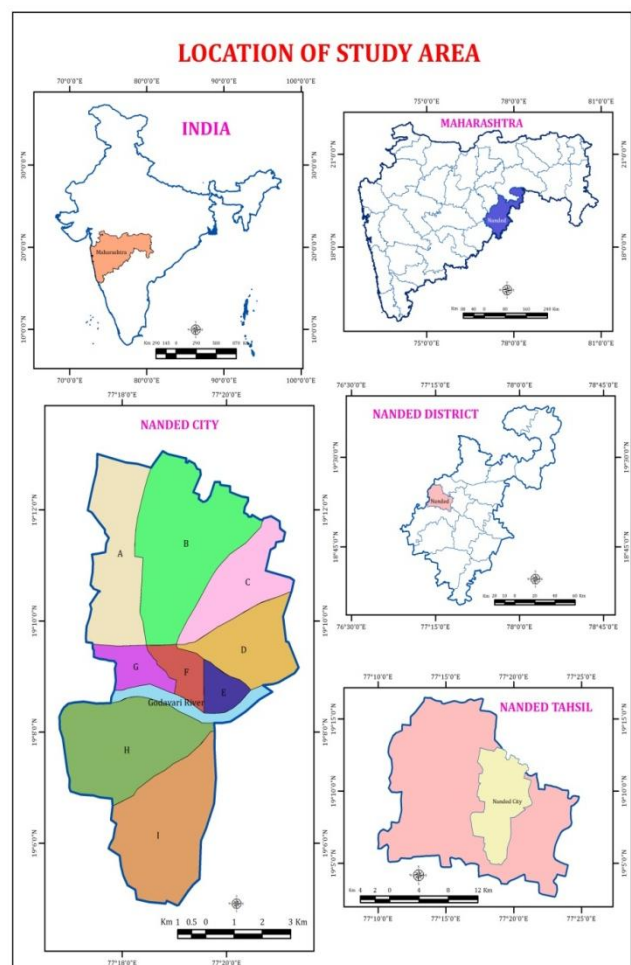

Godavari river divided Nanded city into two parts, the old Nanded is situated on the left bank of Godavari with 20.62 km² area and new Nanded includes Waghala and other six villages on the right banks of the Govadri with 40.82 km² area. The geographical area of New Nanded is double of Old Nanded.

5. Result & Discussion

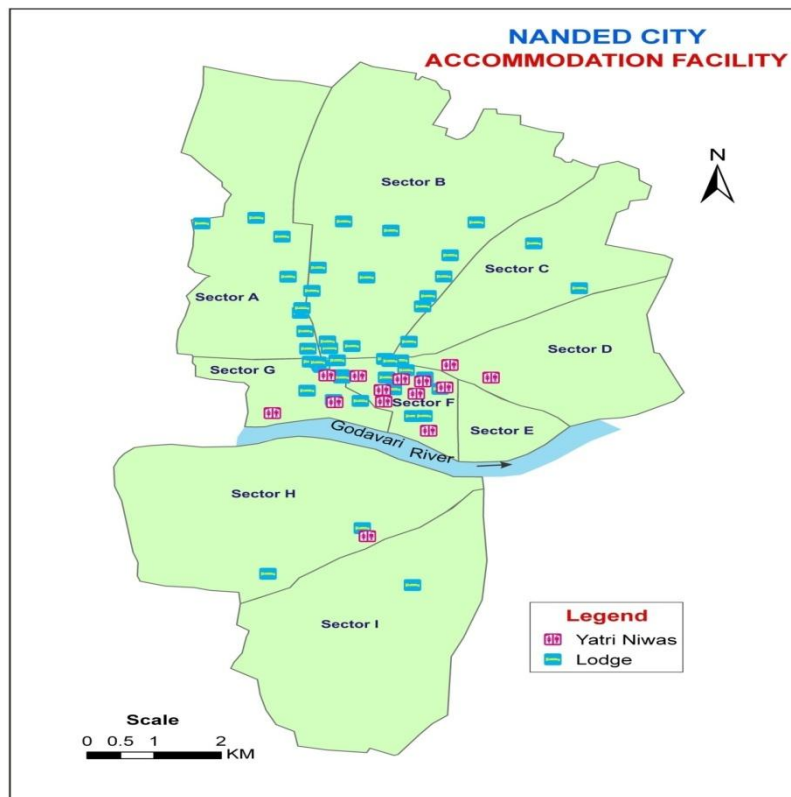
